## 1 ABOUT THE SCHOOL

St. Mary's English Medium School, Chevarambalam, had its humble beginning with 50 students (LKG&UKG together), two sisters as teachers of kindergarten (KG) and one helper in the year 1996, in the most beautiful, proud, ancient Zamorin's city of Malabar. With the grace of Almighty and the dedicated passionate work of the pioneer team, it could elaborate itself to primary school. The first school building was blessed and inaugurated on February 2nd 1997. Now, the school caters students in its KG, primary, secondary and senior secondary classes. It is run by Catholic minority community and managed by sisters of St. Joseph's congregation (S.J. C), Kottayam Archdiocese, through a registered body, "St. Joseph's Educational and Charitable Trust". The sisters of St. Joseph's congregation established its identity in this city by a group of sisters on 1st February 1994.

The Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE) was established in 1958. This national level board of school education in India conducts the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) and Indian School Certificate (ISC) examinations for class X and XII respectively. The school is affiliated to this Council and its affiliation number is KE 089.

Our school takes care of holistic development of children by providing ample opportunities for sports . ### **4. Civil service foundation course**

Alpha Maria academy is a premier coaching centre for civil service foundation course in Kerala, which is coordinated by Rev.Fr.Aji . Students of class VI & VII are making use of this excellent value oriented coaching on all Tuesdays (2pm to 5pm).

### **5. Robotics**

In association with the Smart Robotics India Ltd, a robotics oriented class is given to the students of class V to VIII (Friday – 2pm to 3.30pm). It provides ample opportunity to the students of our school and helps them to participate / present various live projects on robotics conducted in this city (Kozhikode).

Fine is exempted during holidays, examinations and festivals. This exemption is only for the students who return the books on the day immediately after it.
3. If the book is lost, double amount of the price of the book should be remitted. Fine, for the lost book from the given date (date sealed in the front page) of return also should be paid.
4. Only one book will be issued to a student at a time.
5. The school library belongs to each and everyone, so ensure its safety and avoid causing damage to its property, fittings, furniture etc. Handle the book carefully and keep it neatly. Writing with pencil or ink anywhere in the book is strictly forbidden.
6. Students are required to submit their library note book once in a month in which they have to write the brief description about the book they read. This will be valued and grades will be awarded.
7. “Best readers” of the school will be appreciated.
8. Boys & Girls should keep separate queue in all library hours.
9. Bags are not allowed in the library. Keep your bags outside the library.

### **Science Laboratory**

There are 3 fully equipped science labs for the secondary and senior secondary students, one each for Physics, Chemistry, Biology for the science practicals.

### **Computer Laboratory**

At present there are two well equipped computer labs in the school. Students of all classes avail themselves of the computer facility under

the supervision of well qualified, experienced and committed computer teachers. Even the students of the lower classes are given an exposure to the use of computers.

### **Digital classrooms**

In accordance with the advancement in the education sector in terms of information technology, the school has implemented digital class rooms from the year 2011 onwards. This facility is implemented in collaboration with Teach Next Education, Hyderabad. The various videos, slide shows etc enable the students to visualize and learn the syllabus content in detail. It enhances the teaching methodology by providing much assistance in various forms.

### **Student Council**

#### **a) KG & Primary**

Representatives of the students from KG to IV are nominated and selected by the class teachers. They constitute the class cabinet. From these, 9 members are selected to the primary school cabinet.

#### **b) Secondary and senior secondary**

From V to XII representatives are nominated and selected by the class teachers to form the class cabinet. Student council members are elected by the students under General Voting System for the classes VIII to XII. These elected representatives form the school cabinet. They work under the Principal and the teachers for the smooth functioning of the school.

The School cabinet comprises

Head Boy & Head Girl - XI and XII

4 House captains - X

First assistant Head Boy, Head Girl and 4 House captains - IX

Second assistant Head Boy, Head Girl and 4 Houses captains - VIII.

Selection of Sports Minister is based on inter house and inter school sports performance.

## **13 MARIAN SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMME (MSP)**

The school gives opportunities for students to get involved in charity work through which we support the poor and needy of the society.

## 14 ADMISSION RULES

Admission to this school is restricted by conditions of age, ability and conduct. Hence the applicants for admission will be tested and admitted to the standards, if they are found fit.

- 1) The age of admission to LKG is four plus and to standard I is six plus on or before May 31st with corresponding increase of age for the higher classes.
- 2) Registration for KG admission starts from 1st week of November every year. To other classes it starts from 4th week of November.
- 3) A child seeking admission has to register his/her name by paying a registration fee of Rs.150. There after he/she is to take a written test. There is no written test for LKG.
- 4) When applying for admission the following documents are to be submitted:
  - a) Birth Certificate ( Civil)
  - b) Transfer Certificate (TC)
  - c) Progress Report / Mark List ( from the school last studied)
  - d) Copy of Aadhar card
- 5) Pupils coming from Schools outside Kerala will have to get their TC countersigned by the authority concerned.
- 6) The school authorities reserve the right to refuse admission to a pupil without assigning any reason. They also reserve the right to dismiss the student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory.
- 7) Date of birth once recorded at the time of admission will not be changed.

## 15 WITHDRAWAL

Generally withdrawals are not permitted at the end of the school year, unless such withdrawals are warranted by the transfer of the parents or guardians to the other places. In such cases notice of withdrawal must be given in writing . The TC will not be issued unless all dues to the school have been paid. Application for TC in the prescribed form should be submitted at the office by the parents at least two weeks in advance.

unsatisfactory, irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience or defiance of authority, lack of sufficient improvement in studies and conduct even after warnings are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.

2. A student who fails twice in the same class will be sent with his/her TC from the school. The decision of the principal will be final in this matter.

## 16 LEAVE RULES

1. Every pupil should attend the class regularly.
2. Leave will be sanctioned only for genuine reasons.
3. Requests for leave must be noted in the diary and attested by the parent / guardian. Absence owing to illness/ any other reason, extending over 2 days should be communicated to the principal along with a letter/ medical certificate.

## 17 EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

The school holds mid term examination, terminal examinations and annual examinations during the academic year. Besides these, class evaluation is conducted at regular intervals.

1. Promotion is granted on the basis of performance of the pupil for the first terminal, second terminal, and annual examinations.
2. A minimum attendance of 85% is required for the promotion.
3. No re - examination will be conducted in any subject.
4. Absence or failure in any subject excludes a student from being recorded in the order of merit.
5. The decisions of the school authorities will be final with regard to the promotion.

## 18 FEE REMITTANCE

NB: School fees should be paid in three installments on or before 30th of June, September and December without fine. The extension counter in our school will function for two days mentioned in hand book. Next month of the due dates fees can be remitted with a fine of Rs. 50

Fees can be paid through South Indian Bank at Mavoor Road branch/ any other branch. If any student, due to exceptional circumstances is unable to pay the fees on due date, his or her parent shall present the matter to principal and obtain extension of time for payment. However fee must be paid within the extended time without fail. No student will be

allowed to sit for the terminal or annual examination unless all the fees have been paid up to date.

The principal / management has the right to increase the tuition fees or any other fees and also to introduce any kind of additional fee even during the academic year as and when the need arises.

A) The school assembly begins at 7.45 am with a prayer every day. Each class is assigned to conduct the assembly, special occasions and days of observation. On Wednesday there will be Mass PT display of 10 minutes during assembly.

B) Days at St. Mary's conclude with reflections and meditations.

Note : KG assembly starts at 8. 30 am .

## 20 EXTENSION LECTURES AND SEMINARS

A) Value education classes for students and orientation for parents are conducted in every academic year.

B) Orientations are conducted for teachers at the part of CPD (Continuous Professional Development) in order to update the teaching learning process.

## 21 COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE FACILITY

The school has included person in the faculty with specialization in behavioural science and counselling.

## 22 PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION

Parent Teacher Association is a consultative body that gives creative suggestions to the principal and management for the well being and developmental schemes of the school.

## 23 ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The students who pass out from the school join the Alumni (Former Student's Association) when they leave the school.

Dear Parents, guardians and students,

You are requested to co operate with the school in the observance of all rules and regulations laid down below and those announced by the school authorities as and when it is required.

**A) To the students**

1. Each student must have a diary which should be BROUGHT TO THE SCHOOL DAILY. It is the means of communication for the school authorities and staff with the parents about the child.
2. Every student shall respectfully wish the teachers irrespective of the classes they handle. Stand up and wish a teacher or a visitor when he/ she enters or leaves the classroom. Maintain silence in the absence of a teacher. Behave well even out side the school in such a way that your teachers and parents may be proud of you.
3. During the class hours, order and silence need to be maintained. Running about, playing or shouting inside the school campus is strictly prohibited.
4. Come to school always on time neither too early nor late. No student is allowed to remain in the school premises after class hours.
5. The school premises and your classroom should always be kept neat and clean. Since cleanliness is next to Godliness, every student shall consider cleanliness of dress and person as an essential virtue.
6. Any kind of damage to the school properties must be immediately reported to the principal and made good by the respective student who caused it.
7. Every one should attend the morning assembly. Their movement from class to assembly and back, should be in an orderly manner. They should move silently but smartly in single line under the guidance of the class teacher or class leader.
8. Pupils from one class are not allowed to be in other class room during intervals. When pupils move along the corridor to another class or while going up and coming down the stair-case, the rule is KEEP LEFT.
9. Prayers must be recited with respect and devotion. Pupils should not move about at the time of prayer and should be in attention while singing the National Anthem.
10. Newspapers, periodicals, transistors radios, mobile phones, electronic devices etc. are not allowed in the school.

11. The school is not responsible for the loss of books, money, clothes, and other valuable articles.
12. Exemption for pupils from attending assembly or PT will only be granted with written permission from the class teacher.
13. Every student is expected to speak English in the school campus.
14. Scribbling on the bench/desk/ wall/ doors and windows are strictly prohibited. Spitting and washing through the window is forbidden.
15. No gift or donation to be given to the teachers and friends.
16. It is forbidden to buy eatables from street vendors.
17. Fighting and using abusive languages are strictly prohibited
18. Habitual absence and irregularity in home work are recorded and action will be taken.
19. Disobedience in any manner will be punishable
20. Children should not involve in robbery, cheating and forging signature
21. Loitering around in and outside the school campus during and after the class hours is prohibited.
22. Additional body piercings are not permitted, for example eyebrows, nose, ear etc.
- 23. Kindly follow the uniform rules:-**
  - a. Full uniform should be worn always inside the school campus with ID tag
  - b. Tight fitting and sleeveless dress is not allowed on any occasion inside the school campus.
  - c. Use only normal black shoes (canvas, leather shoes and boots are not permitted)
  - d. If any skin allergy problem, use only uniform colour cotton socks.
  - e. Fancy and gold ornaments are not permitted
  - f. Different hair styles and any kind of make up are not allowed.
  - g. Boys should have proper and normal hair cut
  - h. Elder boys should be clean shaved.
  - i. Pants should not be shaped into tight fitting.
  - j. Polish the shoes daily.
  - k. Parents should see that your ward is wearing washed and ironed uniform.

- m. All students should have a handkerchief. KG students (boys & girls) must have it pinned on their uniform (left hand side of their shirt.)

**NB: All these rules should strictly be followed. If not, strict disciplinary action will be taken.**

### **B) To the parents**

1. Parents are expected to cooperate with the school authorities by confirming regularity and discipline, helping their children to prepare lessons and taking a keen interest in the activities of the school.
2. Parents should attend all the CPTM with your ward to evaluate the progress in studies
3. Parents those who require various certificates like conduct certificate, fees certificate of your ward, need to submit a request in writing to the office, at least two days in advance.
4. Parents or other persons are not allowed to see students or meet their teachers during class hours without the permission from the principal.
5. The school hand book is a record and means of communication with the parents. Parents have to check their ward's hand book daily. Sick students should not be sent to school.
6. Criticism of the teachers of the school in the presence of your ward should be avoided, because it may make them lose respect for their teachers.
7. Parents should not insist on any personal religious practices in the school.
8. We are as much interested in your child as you are. So take us into confidence about everything relating to your child.
9. Students who disobey, carry out an illegal or anti social activities or break the rules and code of conduct of the school are liable to have their names struck off from the school register.
10. Identification tags or labels should be there with all the belongings (bags, towels, water bottles etc.) of the children.
11. Bakery items, non- veg and junk food items are not permitted as tiffin. Please send only the necessary quantity of healthy food needed for your ward. Please send a napkin with the tiffin.
