## Happy Independence Day & St. Mary's Day!

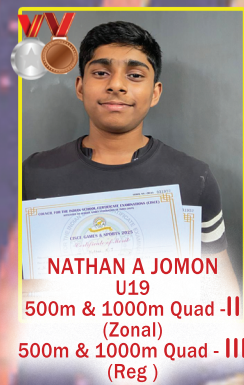
